**MOTION TO PRESENT EXHIBITS AT HEARING**

Now comes the Respondent, James J. Decoulos, who hereby moves to have two plans available for use as chalks at the hearing scheduled in this matter for October 27, 2010 and October 29, 2010. Additionally, the Respondent moves to have all the exhibits available for presentation and reference at the hearing by means of a computer laptop and overhead projector, with a laser pointer available for witnesses to identify specific areas on the projected exhibits.

The two plans will be presented on 24 inch by 36 inch dry mounted boards and placed on an easel. Chalk No. 1 shall be a clean copy of Figure 4 from the Immediate Response Action Status Report dated July 3, 2003, presented by the Board of Registration of Hazardous Waste Site Cleanup Professionals (the "Board") as Exhibit B-21. Because the plan was originally designed for output on an 8 ½ inch by 11 inch sheet, the plan to be presented will be enlarged from its original scale. A copy of proposed Chalk No. 1 is attached hereto.

Chalk No. 2 shall be Respondent's Exhibit RR-8, which was presented to the Board's Complaint Review Team on July 7, 2009. *See* Respondent's Rebuttal Testimony RR-1 at Paragraph 15 on page 7. The plan shall be output at its original scale of one inch equals forty feet. A copy of proposed Chalk No. 2 is attached hereto.

All of the exhibits proposed for display on the overhead projector have been previously posted at: <http://decoulos.com/LSPBoard10AP01.htm>

The two chawks and the overhead projection of exhibits will assist this forum to further understand the positions of each side and the rationale for their arguments. For the foregoing reasons, Respondent moves that the two chawks and overhead projection of all the exhibits be allowed for presentation at the scheduled hearing in this matter on October 27, 2010 and October 29, 2010.
